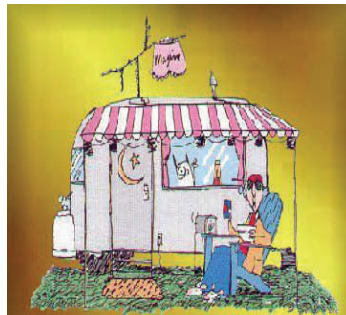

death, or divorce. Perhaps the trauma was war, an accident, suicide of a loved one or a natural disaster: those whose life was twisted in such a way it has never been the same. Without help, the inner pain and turmoil does not go away. Most of this pain does not show on the outside and rarely gets medical care. This kind of pain often lead to dysfunctional and addictive behaviors.
